1. Camp Fee

Early bird discounted fee: \$60 Adults, \$40 Kids (over 2yrs), \$40 Students
After early bird deadline: \$65 Adults, \$45 Kids (over 2yrs), \$45 Students
No family discounts, unless amount exceeds \$250. In that case, max payable will be \$250.

2. What will be provided?

Heated cabins or dorms that will contain bunk beds. Shared restrooms and showers. All meals from Friday dinner through Sunday lunch will be provided. Meals might contain dairy, wheat, nuts, onion, garlic, etc. (that is common in Indian vegetarian meals). Camp booklet and other trivia will also be provided.

3. What to bring?

- Sleeping bag, pillow, comforter, bed spread
- Pair of comfortable clothes for outdoors, rain jacket, extra pair of socks
- Comfortable shoes for walking and hiking
- Traditional Indian dress for Cultural Night
- Personal hygiene items like tooth brush & paste, soap, towel, etc.
- Any medicines that you have to take regularly
- Water bottle
- Flashlight with batteries
- Positive attitude and willingness to participate in ALL activities.

4. Camp timings

Friday, 7pm onwards: Camp registration, dinner, introductions
Saturday, 6am to 10:30pm: Variety programs, Cultural Night
Sunday, 6am until 1pm: Variety programs, concluding ceremony, photo-session, lunch

5. What happens if...?

If you cannot attend the camp full-time, please notify your shakha shikshaks in advance.
We strongly encourage you to attend the whole camp. Please prepare yourself accordingly.
If someone gets injured, we will provide first aid as noted in the consent form.
If something is lost, you can ask around.

6. What do we do in the camp?

We will have extended variety sessions similar to those in our shakha/balagokulam. We will have cultural program on Saturday night. So brush up your hobbies and talents, and form your performance group NOW. We will end with a concluding ceremony and lunch on Sunday. Detailed schedule will be provided at the camp site.

7. Does each family get a cabin/dorm?

All accommodation is divided between men, women, and kids/youth above 6yrs. Smaller kids should stay with the mother. Restrooms will be separate also. So please pack accordingly.
